What stage of planting are you currently in?

- Seed** - In the Seed stage, a leader is identified and begins to develop a core team of people who are interested in planting a prayer furnace. The primary purpose of this stage is to develop a core leadership team.

- Plant** - In the Plant stage, a core team begins to meet regularly (at least once or twice a week) to pray together and opens the prayer meetings to anyone else on campus that wants to pray together. The primary focus of this stage is consistent prayer.

- Feed** - In the Feed stage, with the primary leadership set in place and more prayer meetings added throughout the week, a community forms around the place of prayer and student leaders begin to disciple other students. The added focus that this stage brings to the prayer furnace is discipleship, especially in the form of Bible studies.

- Grow** - In the Grow stage, students begin to evangelize their campus. Student leaders are also focused on developing new leaders within the prayer furnace to lead more prayer meetings and to reach the lost on their campus.

- Multiply** - In the Multiply stage, as the prayer furnace has grown into a more mature community of prayer on campus, the leadership team should begin to think strategically how they can work with nearby campuses to plant prayer furnaces.
